From June 1864-April 1865, General Ulysses S. Grant directed the 10-month Siege of Petersburg from the grounds of Appomattox Plantation at City Point. During this period, City Point served as a supply center for 100,000 Union soldiers. Located at the junction of the James and Appomattox Rivers. It was also one of the busiest seaports in the world. Our tour includes 15 minute video. Park Ranger presentation, parlor, library, Grant’s cabin and outbuildings.

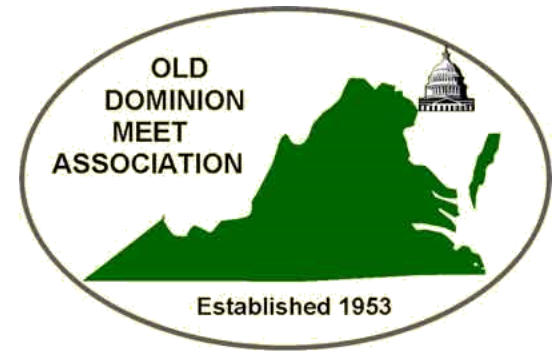
